

Grading your questionnaires

Congratulations for completing both questionnaires! It is now time to compare the results obtained before and after the experience and see whether there was a change as a result of your involvement in ICT Inquiry-Based learning activities.

The following are the answers to each question:

QUESTION	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8	9
ANSWER	D	A	A	C	A	C	D	D	D

As you could see in the form, the Matrix questions only give the possibility to select one answer per item. For each item, you are graded accordingly:

- **strongly disagree**=1 point
- **disagree**=2 points
- **neither agree nor disagree**=3 points
- **agree**=4 points
- **strongly agree**=5 points

For example, in question 10 points range from a minimum of 1 to a maximum of 5 for each item. Hence, the total number of point you might score for that question ranges from 4 to 20, given that question 10 consists of 4 items.
